

## **Nikah Ceremony Guidelines**

Islamic Center of Frisco (ICF) offers Nikah Ceremony services to the community. Following guidelines must be adhered to for utilizing ICF facility for Nikah Ceremony:

## **Reservations/Cancellations**

- 1. All reservation requests must be made no later than two weeks prior to the proposed date of use.
- 2. Reservations for ICF facility are taken on a first come first served basis and are subject to availability.
- 3. Bride/Groom can bring their own Scholar/Imam for Nikah Ceremony.
- 4. Cancellation requests must be emailed to **nikah@friscomasjid.org** at least one week prior to the ceremony.
- 5. Outside scholars / imams may attend to give a talk or lecture for the bride / groom, but our clergy will be required to perform the service.
- 6. Nikah services are subject to a \$150 fee for facility maintenance and our scholars' services.

## **Facility Use Policy**

- 1. Seating, center table and chairs can be setup by ICF staff, if clear and concise written instructions are provided at least one week prior to the ceremony.
- 2. Seating will be segregated for brothers and sisters.
- 3. No decorations are allowed inside the prayer hall except simple table arrangements.
- 4. ICF requires all attendees to wear proper attire to maintain sanctity of the Masiid.
- 5. Salah times will dictate hall occupancy and are given priority. The prayer hall may need to be cleared to accommodate for the congregants to pray.
- 6. **Facility maintenance charges of \$150 apply** for each event and must be paid one week before the ceremony. Payment can be made using Mohid terminals (located in the ICF lobby) or online as a regular donation. Please keep your emailed receipts for confirmation.
- 7. Photographs of the formal Nikah Ceremony can be taken in prayer hall. All other photographs of bride/groom/family/friends can only be taken in the lobby of ICF.
- 8. Music is not allowed.
- 9. No food, drinks, giftboxes, or party favors are permitted inside the prayer halls. All items to be served only in lobby area. Food items must by dry, in nature, and mess free.
- 10. Bride/Groom are responsible any damage caused during the event, either by themselves or their guests. Damages may cause additional incidental charges will be assessed.
- 11. Absolutely NO MEN are allowed in sisters' area on the 2nd floor under any circumstances.
- 12. No furniture or items should be relocated or removed without prior permission of the ICF management.
